Educational visits play an important role in bringing learning to life. Over the past 2 weeks, children across the school have taken part in a range of exciting and enriching trips.

Year 5 enjoyed an inspiring visit to the Eureka! Science and Discovery Museum, where pupils explored hands-on exhibits that encouraged curiosity, collaboration and problem-solving, while reinforcing key scientific learning.

Year 4 had a fantastic visit to the Catalyst Science Discovery Centre, exploring interactive exhibits and taking part in an engaging electricity workshop. The visit supported cross-curricular learning across science, maths, history and geography, helping pupils make meaningful connections between subjects.

Year 6 visited Western Approaches to deepen their understanding of World War II. The immersive experience helped to bring history to life and gave pupils a valuable insight into this important period.

Our Nursery children enjoyed a local walk, exploring their surroundings and developing awareness of their local community.

Well done to our Year 5/6 Netball Team, who played brilliantly last week against other schools in the local area. The team showed excellent teamwork, resilience and sportsmanship, representing the school superbly.
