This week, Year 4 children had a wonderful trip to the Liverpool Anglican Cathedral and the Liverpool World Museum. This visit enriched their learning in both Religious Education and History, and I am pleased to report that the children's behaviour was excellent throughout the day. We believe that such experiences greatly enhance the pupils' understanding of these subjects. Year 2 also visited the Liverpool World Museum as part of their Science and Geography curriculum. They took part in a 'Brilliant Bugs' workshop and had the opportunity to explore the five floors of the museum, which they thoroughly enjoyed.

Last week, our Reception class enjoyed a lovely visit to Croxteth Park Farm, as part of their topic on new life. Engaging with nature and the natural environment in this manner is invaluable to their development.
